### 1. Purpose

Technology Metals Australia Limited (the **Company**) is committed to the responsible management and protection of the environment at all stages from exploration through to the closure and rehabilitation of its operations. We recognise the benefits of working in an environmentally appropriate manner and are committed to minimising impact to the environment.

This policy aims to provide guidance to the Company in its approach to environmental management and protection when undertaking exploration, operational and closure activities.

## 2. Scope

The Company expects that environmental protection and management is supported and followed by all directors, employees, and contractors working for the Company and its subsidiaries.

# 3. Responsibility

- a. The Company's Board is responsible for the overall administration of this Environment Policy.
- b. The Managing Director is responsible for implementation of the commitments set out in this Policy.

### 4. Commitments

The Company is committed to:

- a. Compliance with the applicable environmental laws, regulations, approval/tenement conditions and commitments as a minimum for its environmental practices and management procedures.
- b. Consideration of environmental values and minimisation, where practical, of impacts when planning its activities.
- c. Integration of environmental and rehabilitation processes into its exploration, mine planning, mining and metallurgical activities and provision of sufficient resources to achieve the levels of environmental management protection.
- d. Promotion of environmental awareness among our personnel and contractors to increase understanding of their roles and responsibilities in environmental management.
- e. Identification and assessment of the potential impacts to the environment from all activities and management of environmental risk.
- f. Identification and implementation of activities that look to reduce the consumption of water, fossil fuels and other non-renewable resources and/or minimise the generation of wastes and pollution.

- g. Development of a management system that promotes continual improvement and regular monitoring, audit and review of our environmental performance, including the reduction and prevention of impacts and more efficient use of resources.
- h. Positive stakeholder engagement in relation to potential environmental and closure issues and take their views and concerns into consideration when planning or undertaking our activities.
